Almanac

Easy Honey Drizzled Apple Dumplin's

You will need:

Can of pre made Crispoint Rolls

One apple, cored and cut into eighths

1/4 c. Brown sugar

1 TBSp Cinnamon

1 tbsp butter melted

Local Honey (preferably Ky. Cert. Honey)

presheat oven to 350 degrees.

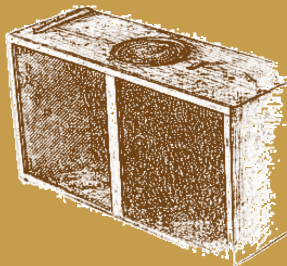
Wash core and slice apple into 1/8 wedges.

In a separate bowl mix cinnamon into brown sugar. Roll out crissoints and place a teaspoon of the sugar/ cinnamon mixture to the widest end. Place apple slice atop sugar and roll towards point of roll making a apple stuffed crissoint. Place on a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper. Repeat for remaining rolls. Brush with melted butter and sprinkle with cinnamon. Bake for about 11-13 minutes– until risen and slightly browned. Immediately drizzle with honey let rest about 2 minutes and serve warm.
